My Mentimeter tips (Michael S.)

- Use it as a small screen focused tool, not a big screen only one
- Build active learning sessions directly into it
- Avoid just doing quizzes – they are lame
- Converting materials into images and uploading them to Menti is robust and full of opportunities
- Don't be afraid of silence and talk about the wrong as well as the right answers
- It takes longer to teach less if you use this approach, but they learn to apply it, not just know it
- Avoid cross platform presentations doable but less seamless.
- Knowing when to display the results is key to what you want them to do
- Open-ended responses are the best way to get students to ask you questions and let you give good direct feedback

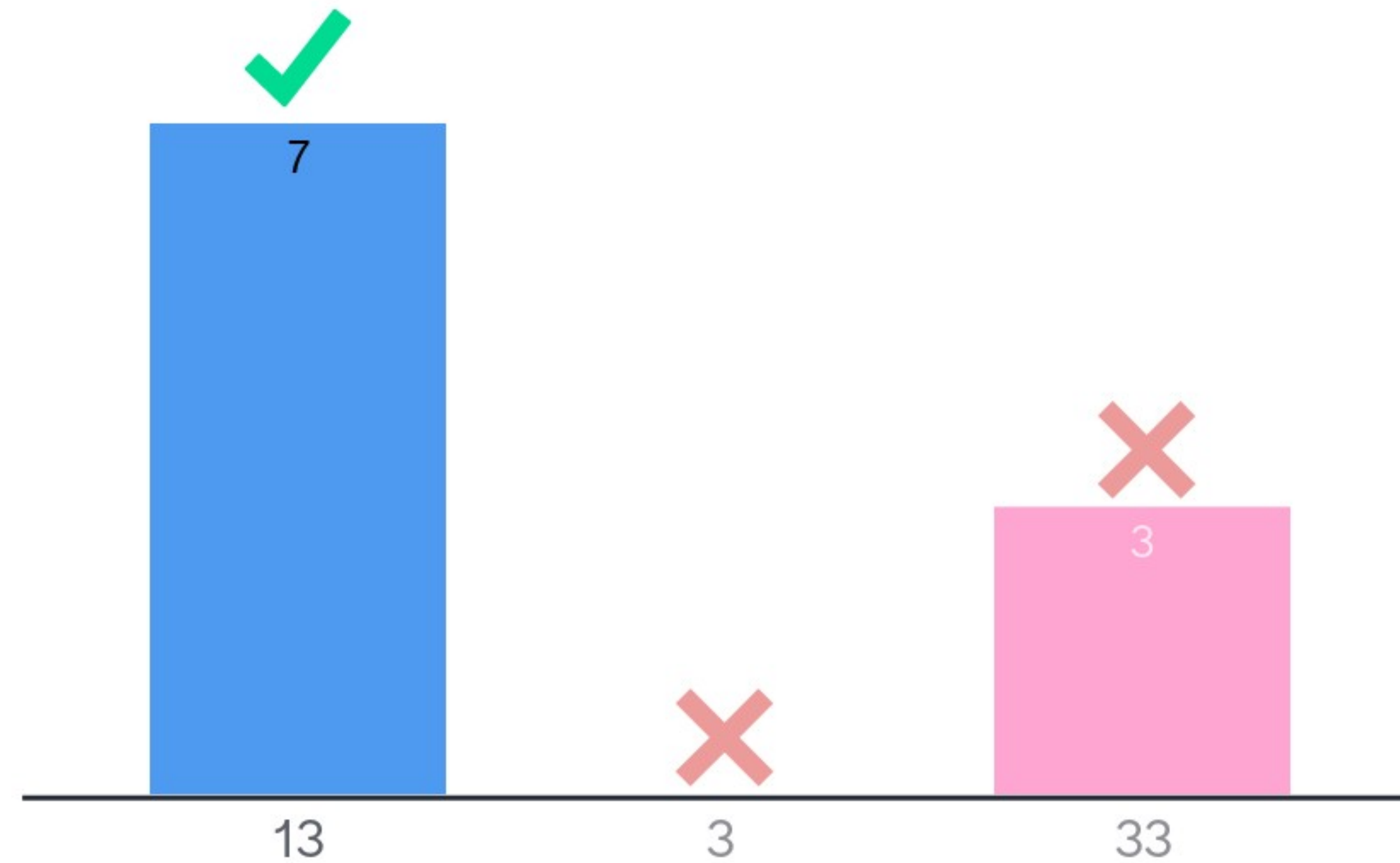

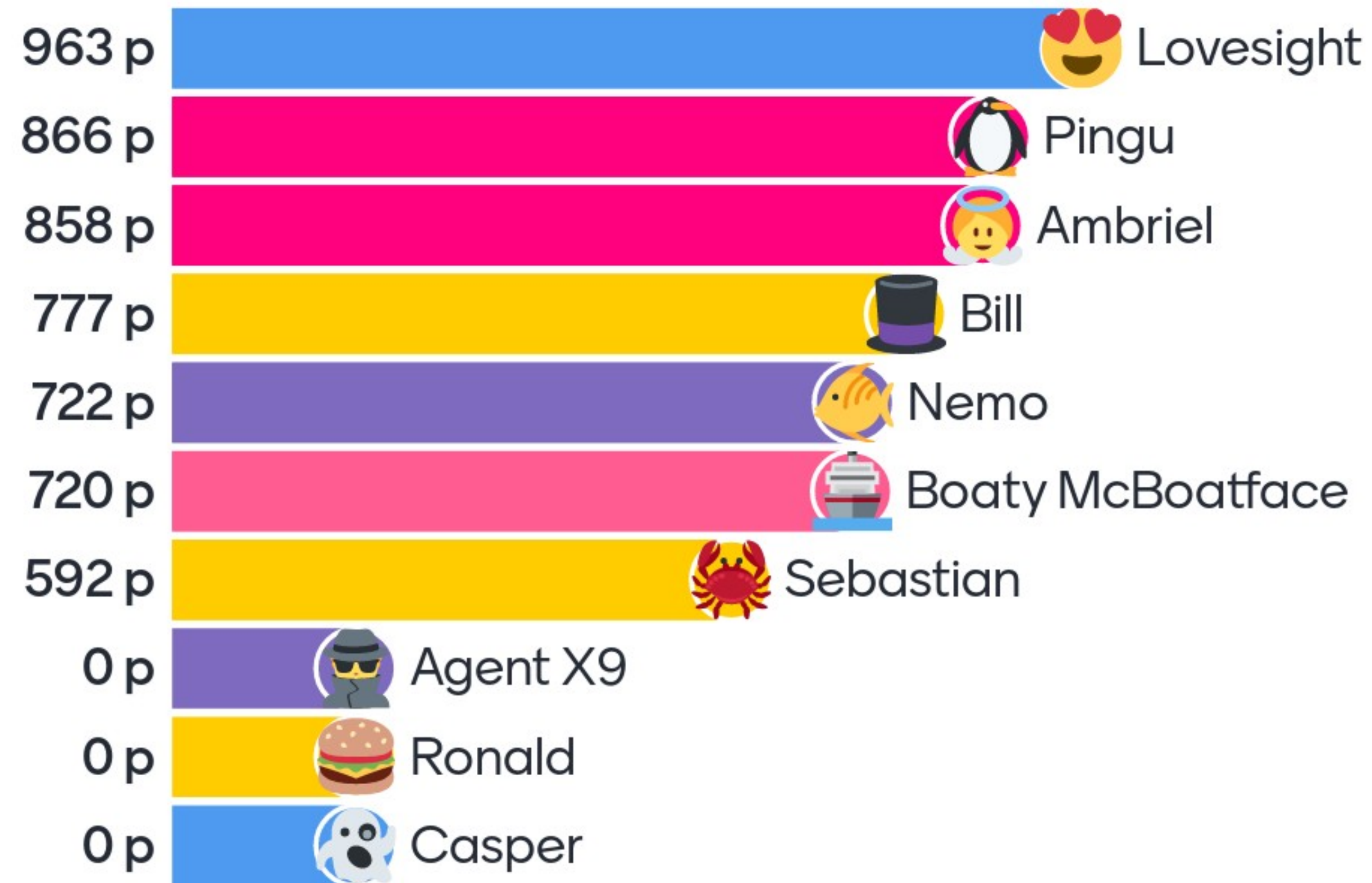
